Repose Initial Block Letterforms

Learn the ABCs of repousse while embossing your hand-drawn calligraphic letterforms. Students will transform initial block letters into color and pewter embossed letters, ideal for adding some “bling” to handmade books, photo albums, book boxes, or individual framing. Students will work with a variety of historic calligraphic faces as well as their own letter forms.

Students are encouraged to bring hand-drawn, bold (wide nib) letters that fit in a 2 inch or 2.5 inch square area. One letter per square! Light-weight copy or tracing paper works best. Or, students may choose from a wide range of faces provided by the instructor.

Supplies- Cutting mat, xacto knife, metal ruler, low tack masking tape, copies of favorite letter forms, wide point pens/markers, pencil and tracing paper. Optional- Paper stumps and sanding blocks. Instructor will provide most supplies. Bring your own lunch!
